## TIC-TAC-TOE <br> Vocabulary

Object: To practice Unit 1: Lesson 1Vocabulary.

## Game Directions:

1. Print one Tic-Tac-Toe board.
2. Print and cut out X and O cards.
3. Print and cut out vocabulary word cards.
4. Place the Tic-Tac-Toe board on a table, leaving the spaces empty.
5. Give X cards to one player and O cards to the other.
6. First player's turn: player two chooses a word card and reads the word to player one. Player one gives the definition of the word. If player one answers correctly, he or she gets to place one of the X or O cards in a space on the board. If answered incorrectly, the turn is over.
7. Second player's turn: player one chooses a word card and reads the word to player two. Player two gives the definition of the word. If player two answers correctly, he or she gets to place one of the X or O cards in a space on the board. If answered incorrectly, the turn is over.
8. The first player to get three X's or O's in a row wins the game and gets to go first in the next game.
